Location: Krabi Province

Our Krabi base offers the perfect entry point for schools looking to help their students develop watersports skills. Arrival at the site is by longtail boat, a typically Thai way to travel on water. Located at Krabi Boat Lagoon this site offers quick and easy access to the Krabi River, which provides perfect conditions for novice sailors.

For those wishing to further develop their skills the coastal waters and islands around Krabi and Ao Nang are simple day trips, which allows your students to take part in the preparation and planning for simple day passages.

The facilities at Krabi Boat Lagoon mean that your students have a quiet environment in which to recharge after a full day of activities.

Krabi River Adventurous Voyage

This expedition makes the most of Krabi; after three days of training, the first day involves sailing along the Krabi River with stops at Krabi town and an overnight stay at a local campsite. The following day is a trip for lunch at the renowned Chicken Island and then back to the base at Krabi Boat Lagoon. TEACHER AND LEADER PRE VISITS

1) A strict focus on your students' development.
